How the Service Works

There are two elements to the service:
Standby and Active

Standby

In this stage, as part of the set up, Trinity deploys low resource Virtual Servers located at our office to act as your Disaster Recovery servers. These servers are used in a 'Standby' status for simply mirroring your live data, and updating the software to keep it in line with the live environment.

Active

In the event that the hosted D.R Service is required, your system is quickly switched to Active, the servers are given the resources they require to operate in a live environment, and access to the system for an agreed number of users is established. Daily back up routines are also invoked. Once the status becomes Active, the service is charged at an increased cost for the period of time that it takes you to replace your own in-house infrastructure.
